In November 2022, Creating

Leadership Program supported by
Migration Council Australia and the
University of New South Wales.

The 4-day leadership program will select 20 Afghan female emerging leaders in sport across Australia.

The program will provide emerging female leaders a sophisticated learning experience with access to expert facilitators, professionals, and develop skills to expand their network, create pathways to further education and employment, and opportunities to lead change in their community.


Why sport?

Participants will be inspired and explore goals and ambitions through a series of workshops, key note presentations, and game design activities.


Believe

Achieve


Participants will apply a human-centred design-thinking process to inspire action to promote sport and wellbeing in their communities.


Application Selection Criteria

- Willing to share your own experiences and knowledge through a range of activities
- Available for the duration of the program and be able to communicate via internet leading up to the program
- Commit to ongoing communication and contribute to the network after the program
- Strong English communication skills






